- Magnet to Grab Wet Noodle Fish Chain (Drop Wet Noodle down an out side wall, then send in Magnet on end of Creep-Zit - the chain will glob onto Magnet so you can pull it to you inside solid ceiling: \$16.95 ea.
- "Z" Tip to Grab Wire: \$16.95 • Replacement Eggbeater Head: \$12.95
- "Magnetic Tip" 6' Bull Nose Rod for Compass type Locator (Very useful for poking hole for wire in walls with styrofoam insulation): \$22.95

This tool will feed thru ceiling trusses in a straight line, or over tiles. Want to go 90 feet in one shot? No problem, just put 2 sets of 20 together and go!

Twenty 3/4" Diam., 27' Rigid Aluminum Alloy Rods (5 oz. ea.) Screw Together (45 ft., put two together for 90 ft.). Feed them thru ceilings & trusses. First Rod slightly bent at tip to go over obstructions, with plastic boot for insulation. Tape wire onto first section to Push wire, tape it onto last section to Pull wire, or tape a hook on to grab wire! Easy to screw together thru small opening - Only needs to be hand tightened! Includes Tough Yellow Vinyl Tote Bag.

• Tie wire to Rubber Throwing Weight (left), and place wire in the "Z". Put the weight with cable through the first truss, and shake the cable off the "Z". Grab the wire on the other side of the truss with the "Z", and pull it down through the next truss. Repeat until you're done! **NO LADDERS!**
